2024 Stall Reservation Policy for Paso Park-Managed Horse Shows

Stall requests can be made by trainers or by independent riders. By completing the online form, texting 805-369-1323 or emailing stalls@pasorobleshorsepark.com to request stalls, you acknowledge that you accept the full financial responsibility of the reservations you make on your behalf individually, or on the behalf of yourself and your training clients. We strongly advise that initial reservations be completed on the stall reservation form at pasorobleshorsepark.com/stall-reservations/. Updates can be made to your reservation at any point prior to the stall confirmation deadline by texting 805-369-1323 or by emailing stalls@pasorobleshorsepark.com.

As soon as possible, you will be notified by Park staff if your reservation can be accommodated or if you are on a waitlist for that show. The following outlines your financial commitment and fees related to stall reservations:

- Prior to the posted <u>Closing Date</u>: No financial penalties for reducing or canceling your total stall reservation.
- After entry <u>Closing Date</u>: You are financially responsible for the full cost of the total number of stalls most recently requested and a \$50 office fee per stall reserved.

In the case that there are still stalls available after the related Closing Date of a horse show, late reservations may be made by texting 805-369-1323 or by emailing stalls@pasorobleshorsepark.com. All late reservations must include a firm stall count and will have 48 hours after sending that count to make final adjustments, after that point you will fall into the financial commitments outlined above.

If your stall needs to change after that deadline you may work with other trainers to take those stalls, HOWEVER:

- Exchanges of stalls between trainers must be communicated to the Paso Park staff in writing for final
 approval and must include both trainers on the communication.
- Any exchanges made between trainers less than 10 days before the start of the show may not be accounted for in the stall chart.
- If there is any misunderstanding between trainers as to who is responsible for the stall cost, it will be
 the trainer that had them originally reserved that is ultimately financially responsible for the stalls.

If something does change please don't hesitate to reach out to us as soon as possible. In the case of a serious medical incident, a doctor's note or veterinarian's note received via email at least 48 hours in advance of the first day of scheduled competition will result in waiving the stall fees; however, the \$50 office fee will still be due. The above language outlines the policy we follow, but with advanced notice, we will always try to work with trainers as best we can while maintaining a fair approach for all competitors.

REFUNDS

In the case that you will no longer be able to attend the horse show, please refer to the chart below to determine if you owe any outstanding fees or will be receiving any refunds. We appreciate your efforts to help us be organized in preparing for the shows and allowing us to accommodate as many competitors as possible. Should an unforeseen circumstance arise, please do not hesitate to reach out to management to discuss the details and determine if an exception can be made.

SHOW FEES

Stall Fee: \$95/stall

- Stall fee covers Friday-Sunday, whether for use as a horse stall, tack room, or grooming stall.
- A fee of \$25 for every stall in the barn will be charged for any barns arriving before Friday or departing after Sunday.
 Early arrival and/or late departure may be allowed only with written permission from management. Early arrival acess begins at 12 p.m. Thursday and late departures must leave by 12 p.m. Monday.
- Stalls are restricted to 200 onsite stalls. No haul-ins are permitted. Every horse on the grounds will receive a stall fee. No sharing stalls.

Class Fee: \$20 per class

CA Drug Fee: \$14

Late Entry Fee: \$50 per entry if submitted after entry closing date. Entries made at the show will be charged a \$100 office fee.

RV Spot: \$150 + 14.5% in T.O.T. & assessments for full weekend (Friday - Sunday). RVs arriving early, or departing late will be charged an additional \$25.

On-Site RV Policy: On-site RV/travel trailer sites are available for reservation on a first come, first served basis.

RULES & REGULATIONS

The following rules and regulations will be enforced throughout the duration of the show and apply to all competitors and riders on the property:

Class Fees: Classes will be charged at \$20/class. The leadline and warm-ups are exceptions.

Entries: Entries received or postmarked after the entries close date including those made on the days of the show, will be charged a $\frac{50}{}$ horse late fee.

Adds & Scratches: Adds and scratches may be made onsite at the show as long as they are completed prior to the start of the related class. Adds and scratches may be made at the back gate of the ring running the class on Saturdays only. Classes scratched at the horse show office prior to the start of the class will receive a full refund. Adds or scratches made at the back gate will be charged \$10/class office fee. Classes that are not scratched will be charged at full price. It is the responsibility of the rider and trainer to ensure the classes entered are correct.

Payment: All payments should be paid by credit card, cash, or check made payable to Paso Robles Horse Park Foundation. Any checks returned by the bank will be charged a \$50 penalty, or 10% of the face value, whichever is greater. Payments made by check or cash will receive a \$10 voucher for credit towards Paso Park Merchandise.

Open Balances: Competitors who do not come into the office to close out at the end of the show forfeit the right to make adjustments on any show charges. Final balances will be automatically charged to the payment method on file.

Credits/Balances: Competitors may be notified of any previous credits or balances from previous Paso Park activity at the time of check-in. Outstanding balances must be paid prior to picking up show numbers. Outstanding balances may be deducted from prize money payments. Outstanding balances may prevent a trainers eligibility to reserve stalls. Competitors that fail to submit a valid form of payment for the full amount of their show bill by 5 pm on Sunday of the show week will be charged a \$50 office fee.

Schedule: The schedule indicated in this prize list is tentative. Based on entry numbers and other real-time factors, schedules may be updated at anytime leading up to the show. The most accurate estimated schedule is posted by 8pm at PasoRoblesHorsePark.com/daily-show-schedule the day prior. Any rounds not complete by 10 minutes before the posted time of the following class/activity may potentially receive a two-minute gate call and not have the opportunity to compete.

Trainer Splits: Trainers may choose to add tack/grooming, feed and bedding orders, RV reservations, competitor show expenses, or any other miscellaneous show purchases to their "trainer splits." Trainers have until

5 p.m. on Friday of the show to complete the trainer split form indicating which competitor accounts to apply the division of expenses to and how to apply the division. If they do not complete this form by the deadline, the office may charge the full amount to the trainer's payment on file. It is fully and solely the trainer's responsibility to indicate what items are applicable to the split and how it should be applied. By completing and submitting your entry form with the indicated trainer's name on it, you accept the responsibility to be financially responsible for any assigned splits from that trainer for all costs related to the show you are entering. The horse show management is not able to intervene in a trainer's direction of how to assign those expenses.

Management Rights: Management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or cancel entries, awards, or prizes, and/or adjust the time schedule, combine, scratch, or move classes as necessary without claims or damage. A two-minute gate call will be requested and enforced. All judge's decisions are final.

Helmets: All professionals and non-professionals riding on the Paso Park property must wear securely fastened protective headgear, which meets ASTM/SEI standards and carries the SEI tag. Any rider violating this rule at any time will immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.

Stall Use: A flat fee of \$95/stall will be charged for each stall, tack room, and/or grooming stall reserved. This fee grants access to a reserved stall beginning on Friday at Noon through Sunday at the conclusion of the show. Stalls are 12'x12' and will be assigned by management.

Early Arrivals: Those traveling from farther away may request an early arrival to be granted at management's discretion. Early arrivals open on Thursday at noon early arrivals or late departures will be charged \$25 per stall per night.

Feed & Shavings: The Paso Robles Horse Park Feed Office will be open during show dates, and will be offering hay and shavings. Alfalfa, orchard, timothy hay, and bagged shavings will be available. For advance orders please email feed@pasorobleshorsepark.com or complete the form found under the Competitor Resources page on the Paso Park website. Orders can be made at the show in the office. Competitors may bring their own feed and bedding but they may not receive a feed or bedding delivery from an outside company.

Non-Competing Horses: Due to limited availability at these shows, all horses on the grounds must be competing. If circumstances allow and noncompeting horses are permitted with management's permission, a nonshowing fee of \$50 per horse will apply. To be considered a competing horse, an entry must be shown in a judgement class.

RV Parking & Hookups: 52 RV parking spots with water and power hookups are available for rental. A flat fee of \$150 will be charged. Additionally, in

compliance with the City of Paso Robles an additional 14.5% will be collected to pay T.O.T. and tourism assessments. This will grant access to the spot beginning at noon on <u>Friday through Sunday</u> at the conclusion of the show. All RV reservations will be filled on a first come, first served basis. Early arrivals or late departures will be charged an additional \$25/RV space.

Refunds: At management's discretion, entry fees will be refunded in full, less a \$50 office charge, with a veterinary certificate or medical doctor's note submitted at least 48 hours prior to the start of the show's first judged class. Please refer to the refund information on page 6 to determine if you are elligible for a refund.

Schooling: No juniors or amateurs are allowed to school over fences without their trainer in the area.

Lunging: Lunging in the designated lunging areas will be permitted on <u>Friday</u> between Noon and 6 p.m., and again on <u>Saturday and Sunday, during daylight hours.</u> Any lunging taking place in the GGT warm-up or competition arenas will result in a \$500 fine.

Warm-Ups: \$10 warm-up rounds will be available on Friday. Rounds are three (3) minutes long. Additionally, a \$10 warm-up class will be offer Saturday in each ring in a progressive height format. These classes will utilize set courses. Please note, warm-up closing times will be posted at back gates and strictly enforced.

Competition Attire: All riders must be in appropriate attire, which consists of a hunt coat, a shirt with collar, breeches, and tall boots or boots and half chaps or jodhpurs.

General Comment on Attire: The hunter/jumper sport is one based in tradition. We ask that as you make decisions related to attire and equipment you take this into consideration. Management reserved the right to disqualify any competitor from being judged or riding if a lack of consideration for appropriate attire seems apparent.

Hunter Equipment: Horses shown in hunter classes must have the proper equipment. Equipment requirements include: if a martingale is used, only a standing martingale is permitted, no figure-eight or dropped nosed bands, and no horse boots. No martingales are allowed in flat classes.

Equitation Equipment: Horses shown in equitation classes must have the proper equipment. Equipment requirements include: if a martingale is used, only a standing martingale is permitted, no figure-eight or dropped nosed bands, and either no horse boots or leather equitation boots. No martingales are allowed in flat classes.

Jumper Equipment: Horses shown in jumper classes must have the proper equipment. Equipment requirements include: if a martingale is used, a standing, running or German martingale is permitted; at 1.20m and above only running martingales are permitted. USEF-approved horse boots are permitted on both front and hind.

Photo and Video Consent: By competing at or attending competitions or events at the Paso Robles Horse Park, you grant permission to the unrestricted rights to use photographs and/or video footage of yourself, your family, your guests, and/or your animal for the purpose of promotion of the Paso Park in various mediums.

Draw lines: No draw lines allowed in the show ring or to school over fences. **Awards and Prizes:** Ribbons will be awarded in all classes 1st - 6th. Prizes will be available to 1st in each class. Ribbons and prizes can be collected at Celebration Station.

Dogs: All dogs must be on a leash. Owners are subject to a \$50 fine for any dog not on a leash or for owners who do not pick up after their dog.

Trainers: No trainers are allowed on foot in the show ring during competition. **Professionals:** Professionals may only ride in open division classes. Any

professionals riding in classes designated for Jr/Am will be disqualified for the remainder of the day.

Class Splits: At the discretion of the judge or show management, a class may be split into multiple sections. In the case of flat classes, each section will be admitted separately by the back gate or split once in the ring by the judge. In the case of classes over fences, a "California Split" may be used to award multiple sets of placings.

Non-Comp/Hor Concours Rounds: Permitted only at manager's discretion. Rounds will be charged at \$20/round.

Trailer Parking: All trailers must be parked in the designated trailer parking lot near the entrance of the Paso Park. Any trailer not parked in the correct location may have its hitch locked and may be applicable to a \$50 fee.

Private Facility: This is a privately owned and operated facility. Any horse on the grounds must be associated with and entered into the current competition taking place. Cases of exception, including utilizing the facility to transfer shipping horses, must be approved through show management.

Cell Phones: Active use of cell phones or celluar transmission devices is not permitted in any competition or warm-up arena.

Remount: Riders are not allowed to mount or remount their horse from within the show ring for any reason during competition.

Vaccinations and Horse Health: Per GR845 Equine Vaccination Rule: At Federation licensed competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Competitors may be asked to provide proof of vaccination upon check-in or prior to entering the property. All horses on the facility must have their temperature monitored twice daily for the 72 hours prior to their arrival and throughout the duration of their stay at the Paso Park. Any horse exhibiting a temperature over 101.5° F must be reported to management immediately.

PASO PARK DEFINITIONS

Progressive Warm-Ups: Warm-ups are offered on Saturday in each ring and tentatively offered on Sunday pending schedule availability. Each horse may add up to one un-judged warm-up round at any height. The warm-up round must be completed prior to any judged rounds at that height. You must complete the posted course.

Walk/Trot Flat: To be eligible, horse and rider must not have competed in a class over 2' at this show.

W/T Hunter Hack: Horses will first be worked and judged on the flat. Riders may be asked to demonstrate walk and trot gaits. Following the completion of the flat phase, riders will be directed by the judge to jump two fences set in a line. Riders may either walk or trot the jumping portion.

Hunter Hack: Horses will first be worked and judged on the flat. Riders may be asked to demonstrate walk, trot, and canter gaits. Following the completion of the flat phase, riders will be directed by the judge to jump two fences set in a line.

Hunters or Equitation Over Poles: Fences will consist of jump poles laid flat on the ground. To be eligible, rider and horse combination must not be competing in classes greater than 2'7", or .80m in height. Riders may choose to complete the course at the trot or the canter.

Cross-Rail Hunters or Equitation: Fences are not to exceed 18" at the center. To be eligible, rider and horse combination must not be competing in classes greater than 2'10" or .85m in height. No combinations or oxers.

Short/Long Stirrup Hunters or Equitation: Fences are not to exceed 2'. Horse rider combinations are not to have shown at heights above 3' in past competitions. No combinations or oxers.

Pre-Child/Adult Hunters or Equitation: Fences are not to exceed 2'3". This height may include oxers.

Low Child/Adult Hunters or Equitation: Fences are not to exceed 2'6".

Modified Child/Adult Hunters or Equitation: Fences are not to exceed 2'9".

Child/Adult Hunters or Equitation: Fences are not to exceed 3'.

Lindsay Ashburn Memorial Green Rider Medal: Hosted at the Paso Park Schooling Show Series, the Paso Park B Series, and other California shows, the Green Rider Medal features fences not to exceed 2' in height. Class is to be held over a hunter-style equitation course. A minimum of two riders must complete the course in order for the round to qualify for points. The top four riders (if available) in the class may be asked to work off at the judge's discretion. Alternatively, the course designer may choose to integrate the

test(s) into the posted course. Tests may include USEF equitation tests 1-6 and 10-13. This class is open to all junior and amateur riders who have not competed at heights above 3'. Riders may not cross enter in the Paso Park Medal. Finals of the Green Rider Medal will be held at the Turkey Trot & Jump Show. Points from shows hosting the medal between December 1, of the previous year through October 31, of the current year or at the Turkey Trot & Jump Show are eligible to qualify a rider for the Finals. Points are to be awarded as follows: 1st - 7pts, 2nd - 5pts, 3rd - 4pts, 4th - 3pts, 5th - 2pts, 6th - 1pt. Riders with 7 points or more are invited to participate in the Green Rider Medal Final. Any rider that has previously won the Green Rider Medal Final is no longer eligible to compete.

Paso Park Medal: Hosted at the Paso Park Schooling Show Series, the Paso Park B Series, and other California shows, the Paso Park Medal features fences not to exceed 2'6" in height. A minimum of two riders must complete the course in order for the round to qualify for points. The top four riders (if available) in the class may be asked to work off at the judge's discretion. Alternatively, the course designer may choose to integrate the test(s) into the posted course. Tests may include USEF equitation tests 1-17. This class may be run in either a jumper or hunter competition arena; jumper-style tack is permitted, no time allowed is to be considered. This class is open to all junior and amateur riders. Riders may not cross enter in the Lindsay Ashburn Memorial Green Rider Medal. Finals of the Paso Park Medal will be held at the Turkey Trot & Jump Show. Points from shows hosting the medal between December 1 of the previous year through October 31 of the current year or at the Turkey Trot & Jump Show are eligible to qualify a rider for the Finals. Points are to be awarded as follows: 1st - 7pts, 2nd - 5pts, 3rd - 4pts, 4th - 3pts, 5th - 2pts, 6th - 1pt. Riders with 7 points or more are invited to participate in the Paso Park Medal Final. Any rider that has previously won the Paso Park 2'6" Medal Final is no longer eligible to compete.

Hunter Derby: This class is open to all riders. This is a single-round derby with the course set at 2'3" and may feature up to four higher height options of 2'6"-2'8".

Up-and-Coming Hunters: Classes 900, 901, 902, and 903 are only open for horses 7 or younger OR with less than 365 days of training undersaddle. The flat class will be walk/trot, with an option to canter. No non-judged rounds will be permitted during these classes. A non-judged warm up is permitted directly preceding this class.

PASO PARK DEFINITIONS

SBCRC Hunt Seat Medal, 17 & Under: This class is open to junior riders who are members of SBCRC. To be shown over a course of a minimum of eight fences 2'9" in height, and may include one combination. The top four riders (if available) in the class must be asked to work off. A minimum of two entries must be judged over the course, in order to qualify for the finals. The top two riders from each show will qualify for finals. It may be combined with the 18 & over medal where points will be awarded to the riders in each division equally. There will be 2 firsts and seconds, etc. A previously qualified rider may ride again. If that rider places first the next two places qualify. All courses shall be posted one-half hour before the class. The winner of the finals each year shall be ineligible for any future medal class in the same division.

SBCRC Hunt Seat Medal, 18 & Over: This class is open to amateur riders who are members of SBCRC. It follows the same specifications as SBCRC 17 & under medal.

SBCRC Green Rider Medal: This class is open to junior and amateur members of SBCRC who qualify over fences in the medal class. To be shown over a course of up to eight fences not exceeding 2'3" in height, with no combinations. At the judge's discretion, the top four riders in the class may be asked to work off, using one or more of USEF Medal tests 1, 3, 4, 5, and 6 (trot and canter only) or any other tests that the judge deems suitable for the level of riders in the class. A minimum of two entries must be judged over the course, in order for the winner to qualify for the finals. A previously qualified rider may ride again. If that rider places first the next two places qualify. The top two riders from each show will qualify for finals.

Betsy Woods Horsemanship Medal: A two-phase event designed to test a rider's ability to demonstrate proper horsemanship as it relates to work on the flat and over fences. Riders in the flat phase may be asked to ride at the walk,

rising trot, rising trot demonstrating a lengthening of stride, sitting trot, canter, hand gallop, and counter canter. No martingales are permitted and only traditional hunter-type bits may be used (gags, leverage bits, and hackamores are prohibited). The jumping phase will take place over hunter/jumper type obstacles set at 2'6". The course may include a bending line, roll back to a single jump, a hand gallop to a single jump and a trot fence. The course must have at least two changes in direction. Combinations are not allowed. The course should be ridden in a direct and prompt fashion. The jumping phase will be scored using the open numerical system. Riders who have not won a hunter, jumper, or equitation class at 3' or over may compete in this class. The top two riders from each show will qualify for finals. A previously qualified rider may ride again. If that rider places first the next two places qualify. A minimum of two (2) entries must be judged over the course for the class to fill.

Jumper Tables: All jumper classes will be run at Table II Sec. 2 (a, b, c, or d) or optimum time unless otherwise specified. The table will be specified at the backgate on the course map.

Starter Jumpers (Jr/AM): Fences are not to exceed .60m. No oxers. Table IV, Sect. 1 – Optimum time will be utilized in all classes.

Modified Pre-Child/Adult Jumpers: Fences are not to exceed .70m. Table IV, Sect. 1 – Optimum time may be utilized.

Pre-Child/Adult Jumpers: Fences are not to exceed .80m.
Low Modified Child/Adult: Fences are not to exceed .85m.
Modified Child/Adult Jumpers: Fences are not to exceed .95m.
Low Child/Adult Jumpers: Fences are not to exceed 1.00m.

Child/Adult Jumpers: Fences are not to exceed 1.10m.

Modified Jr/AO Jumpers: Fences are not to exceed 1.15m.

Jr/AO Jumpers: Fences are not to exceed 1.20m.
