

PASO PARK PROGRAMS



SCHOOLING SHOWS

Offered at a cost much lower than other comparable experiences on the West Coast, these shows deliver upper-level show experience with strategic horse and rider development pathways.

2EX YOUNG HORSE PROGRAM

This program supports show jumping horses seven and under through stall discounts and complimentary classes. The goal is to create opportunities for developing show jumpers to gain experience and exposure in the horse show environment.

EDUCATIONAL HOURS

We host four of these each year at the Paso Park Pathway Shows. They feature an industry professional talking about their role in the show jumping world, their career path, and answering questions from attendees. We've featured judges, course designers, the owner of the scoreboard company, stewards, and horse nutritionists.

SHOW SCHOLARSHIPS

All shows have a scholarship available to help offset the costs of a competitor's show bill. These scholarships are awarded to applicants who embody the Paso Park values and have demonstrated an interest in advancing their riding experience through the programs of Paso Park shows.

INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

This fall we'll be launching an internship program to provide an opportunity for those interested in learning more about getting involved with working on the management side of the horse shows.

DEVELOPING RIDER DISCOUNTS

Riders who participate in Pony Club, IEA, IEL, and collegiate riding teams are eligible for stall discounts at our Pathway shows.

USHJA EAP CLINIC

The Paso Park facility and equipment are made available to host the US Hunter Jumper Association's Emerging Athletes Program Regional Clinic each year. This unique clinic offers 5 days of intensive learning for both mounted riding instruction and stable management, focused on understanding horse care.
