ABOUT

The Paso Robles Horse Park opened gates in 2015 with the goal of hosting world-class Hunter/Jumper competitions. The natural beauty of the property's oak tree-filled landscape with vast views overlooking the hills of Paso Robles, make it an idyllic setting for a competitive horse park.

TODAY

Since bringing show management in-house in 2018, the Paso Park has seen year-over-year growth in competitor numbers and consistent progress in success measures of the Foundation's mission. The unique model of containing both facility and show management within the same team, allows for an experience that fully embodies the spirit of the Paso Robles destination and the unique aspects of the Paso Park.

Last year's season brought positive trends in both competitor attendance and marketing reach. Annual figures reflect the following stats:

- 12 total show jumping competitions
- Over 112,424 annual website visits
- Over 5,219 Instagram followers
- Over 6,534 Facebook likes
- Over 4,700 Email subscribers
- The Classic Series shows saw an average growth of 8% year-over-year in competitor attendance
- The Pathway Show Series remained steady in competitor attendance
- The Schooling Show Series remained steady in competitor attendance

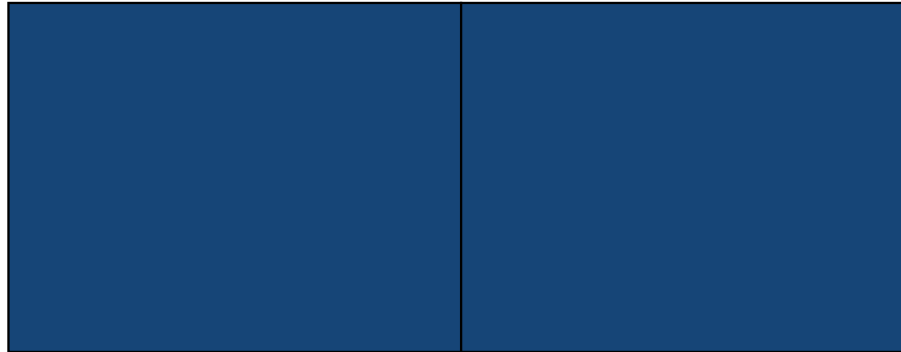

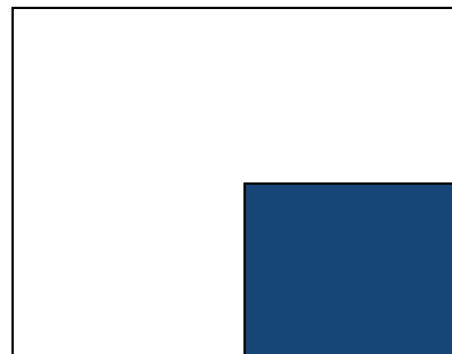
