2026 Stall Reservation Policy for Paso Park-Managed Horse Shows

Stall requests can be made by trainers or by independent riders. By completing the online form, texting 805-369-1323 or emailing stalls@pasorobleshorsepark.com to request stalls, you acknowledge that you accept the full financial responsibility of the reservations you make on your behalf individually, or on the behalf of yourself and your training clients. We strongly advise that initial reservations be completed on the stall reservation form at pasorobleshorsepark.com/stall-reservations/. Updates can be made to your reservation at any point prior to the stall confirmation deadline by texting 805-369-1323 or by emailing stalls@pasorobleshorsepark.com.

As soon as possible, you will be notified by Park staff if your reservation can be accommodated or if you are on a waitlist for that show. The following outlines your financial commitment and fees related to stall reservations:

- Prior to the posted [Closing Date](#): No financial penalties for reducing or canceling your total stall reservation.
- After entry [Closing Date](#): You are financially responsible for the full cost of the total number of stalls most recently requested and a \$50 office fee per stall reserved.

In the case that there are still stalls available after the related Closing Date of a horse show, late reservations may be made by texting 805-369-1323 or by emailing stalls@pasorobleshorsepark.com. All late reservations must include a firm stall count and will have 48 hours after sending that count to make final adjustments, after that point you will fall into the financial commitments outlined above.

If your stall needs to change after that deadline you may work with other trainers to take those stalls, HOWEVER:

- Exchanges of stalls between trainers must be communicated to the Paso Park staff in writing for final approval and must include both trainers on the communication.
- Any exchanges made between trainers less than 10 days before the start of the show may not be accounted for in the stall chart.
- If there is any misunderstanding between trainers as to who is responsible for the stall cost, it will be the trainer that had them originally reserved that is ultimately financially responsible for the stalls.

If something does change please don't hesitate to reach out to us as soon as possible. In the case of a serious medical incident, a doctor's note or veterinarian's note received via email at least 48 hours in advance of the first day of scheduled competition will result in waiving the stall fees; however, the \$50 office fee will still be due. The above language outlines the policy we follow, but with advanced notice, we will always try to work with trainers as best we can while maintaining a fair approach for all competitors.

PASO PARK JUMPER *Team Challenge*

Paso Park Fall Classic | *October 21-25, 2026*

\$30,000 in Prize Money Offered!

The Paso Robles Horse Park Jumper Team Challenge features \$30,000 in prize money and a three-round team format designed to showcase skill, strategy, and horsemanship across 1.10m–1.30m heights.

Teams of three will compete in Speed, Power & Speed, and a top-four Short Track Final to determine the champions. A special bonus will also be awarded to the highest-placing Non-Pro Team. Entry Fee: \$500.

Team Composition

Each team will be comprised of **three horse and rider combinations**; each combination will represent the team across three heights **1.10m, 1.20m, and 1.30m**. No horse may compete across multiple heights or multiple teams. Teams may select amongst themselves or individuals can apply to be assigned to a team by management. Each team may have up to one professional rider represented; there will be a bonus allocated specifically to the top-placing team without a pro. There is no limit on the total number of teams that may compete. **The deadline to submit a team or apply to be assigned to a team will be Monday, October 19, 2026 at 5 p.m.** Team submissions should be made by completing the online form or by completing the paperwork at the show office.

Round 1

Speed

Thursday, October 22, 2026

- Competition begins at 1.10m, followed by 1.20m, then 1.30m.
- Teams compete in the order drawn at the Riders' Meeting.
- Each height will follow the same team order.

Scoring:

- Results determined by total faults and time.
- Teams with equal faults will be placed by cumulative team time.
- In the case of elimination or retirement, the team will receive 20 faults more than the highest fault total recorded at that height.

The USHJA National Hunter Derby features a two-round format with a minimum of two judges utilizing a numerical system to score competitors in the Classic Hunter Round (first round) on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality and substance, and movement. A second round will feature a Handy Hunter course designed to reflect brilliance of pace and handiness. In each round, following the judges' base score, one point will be added for each high-option fence jumped; up to a maximum of four high options may be included. Fences are set at 3' with four high-option fences set at 3'5". Full specs can be found with the United States Hunter Jumper Association. There is a same day add/scratch fee of \$50 for the Hunter Derby.

USHJA International Hunter Derby - Class 6

The USHJA International Hunter Derby features a two-round doormat with a minimum of two R-licensed judges utilizing a numerical system to score competitions in the Classic Hunter Round (first round) on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality and substance, and movement. The top 12 scoring horses from the first round will be asked to return for a second round will feature a Handy Hunter course designed to reflect brilliance of pace and handiness. In each round, following the judges' base score, one point will be added for each high-option fence jumped; up to a maximum of four high options may be included. The total scores of each horse-and-rider combination from each round will be added together to determine their final overall Hunter Derby score. Fences are set at 3'6" to 4'0" in height; the option fenced must be set at a minimum of 4'0" and cannot exceed four total options. Full specs can be found with the United States Hunter Jumper Association. There is a same day add/scratch fee of \$50 for the Hunter Derby.

USHJA International Hunter Derby - Class 6

This show is conducted under the USHJA Zone 10 Specifications. These can be found at www.ushja.org/application/files/4917/2709/9247/2025_Zone_10_Specifications.pdf

Junior/Amateur Hunter Derby - Class 17

This class consists of a two-round derby. The first round will be judged as a traditional hunter round, scoring riders on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality and substance, and movement. The second round will invite the top ten back to compete over a handy course offering the opportunity to demonstrate brilliance of pace and handiness. Fences are set at 3'0" with up to four high-option fences set up to 3'5". The Junior/Amateur Hunter Derby is not sanctioned by USHJA and will not count for zone Horse of the Year bonus points. Prize money will be awarded as follows: 1st - 30%, 2nd - 22%, 3rd - 15%, 4th - 10%, 5th - 7%, 6th - 6%, 7th - 5%, 8th - 5%. There is a same day add/scratch fee of \$50.

Hunter Classics - Classes 8-16 and 29-34

Horses or ponies must have competed in at least two classes of the related section unless specified otherwise; the final round over fences in each section is to count as the first round of the respective Classic. All hunter rounds will be scored under the open numerical judging system. If a horse is not present for either the first or second round of a classic, that horse will receive a zero score in that round. Scores will be totaled from both the first and second round to determine the winners. All overall ties will be broken by using second round scores. Prize money divided 30%, 22%, 15%, 10%, 7%, 6%, 5%, 5%. Classes 10 and 11 the Junior and A/O Hunter Classics and classes 14 the Children's and A/A Hunter Classics will not be eligible for Horse of the Year bonus points. Full list of Hunter Classics listed on page 10.

Short/Long Hunter Derby - Class 35

This derby will be conducted in a "hunt & go" format. Courses will consist of 10-14 fences with at least 2 high options 2" larger than the posted height in both rounds.

Pony Hunter Derby - Class 36

This derby will be conducted in a "hunt & go" format. Courses will consist of 10-14 fences with at least 2 high options 2" larger than the posted height in both rounds.

Derby Low Child/Adult Derby - Class 37

This derby will be conducted in a "hunt & go" format. Courses will consist of 10-14 fences with at least 2 high options 2" larger than the posted height in both rounds.

Hunter warm-up cards are held open with corresponding hunter classes. Warm-up cards will be closed before the start of any medal classes. Jumper warm-up cards will be closed before the start of any following classes. Warm-up rounds will be judged, thus all rules pertaining to rounds (including following the posted course) will be followed, but no scores or ribbons will be awarded.

IMPORTANT POLICIES OF THE SHOW

Adds & Scratches Due By 5:00 p.m. Daily

All changes for the next day, including adds and scratches, must be made by 5:00 p.m. each day in the office or on HorseSpot.net. This allows the next day's schedule to be created with class counts and times, and made available to everyone in a timely manner. These shows will only allow same-day adds if the schedule in each ring allows. Unless otherwise posted at the office, it should be assumed there are no same-day adds. Any changes made after 5:00 p.m., if accepted, will be considered SAME DAY and will fall under the policy for same day adds and scratches. There will be a \$5 per transaction fee for late entries.

Canceling & Combining Of Classes

Classes with less than the entry minimums may be either canceled or combined with other classes, at management's discretion. Often this is determined at 5 p.m. the day prior to the class. Please enter in all your desired classes by 5 p.m. the day before.

Scratch Your Classes BEFORE They Start

Same day scratches must be made in the Horse Show Office or on HorseSpot.net **BEFORE** the start of the class. If you don't scratch them in the office or online, or try to scratch them after the class has started, you will be charged the full entry fee. **Back Gate adds or scratches are not permitted.**

No Same Day Adds

Unless otherwise posted at the Horse Show Office, same day adds are not permitted in any arenas.

Posted Time Schedule

The most accurate estimation of the daily time schedule will be completed after adds and scratches have been entered. We strive to post this schedule by 7:00 p.m. the day prior. The schedule can be found at www.PasoRoblesHorsePark.com/Daily-Show-Schedule.



RULES & REGULATIONS

COMPETITION

» **ATTIRE** - It is the tradition of the show that riders be correctly attired for the class in question, that attendants be neatly dressed and the horses properly presented. Management may, at its discretion, bar any person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience. If competing in any judged class, riders must wear a hunt coat or a shirt with a collar, breeches and tall boots or jodhpurs.

» **AWARDS** - Trophies/prizes to first, ribbons through 8th place and, unless otherwise stated in this prize list, prize money divided as follows: 30%, 22%, 15%, 10%, 7%, 6%, 5%, 5%. Prize money will be awarded at time of check-out and applied to entry fees or mailed within 30 days of the show to the contact noted on entries. If an awards ceremony is conducted, all ribbon winners are required to attend and participate. Failure to participate in awards ceremony without explicit permission from management may result in forfeiture of related prize money, and any prizes or ribbons. A valid social security or federal tax ID number must be provided to receive any prize money, either credited to your account or in the form of a check. Individuals that do not provide current and accurate information in the prize money section of the entry form acknowledge that they may not receive winnings in a timely manner. Paso Park staff will make reasonable efforts to contact the payee for information. However, if after 12 months following the last day of the competition prize money hasn't been collected, prize money may be forfeited.

» **CHAMPIONSHIPS** - Champion and Reserve Champion to be awarded as per current USEF rules. Points for placings to be awarded 1st-10, 2nd-6, 3rd-4, 4th-2, 5th-1, 6th-1/2.

» **HANDY HUNTER** - For indicated hunter sections and divisions one class will feature a handy course. This course will be the second over fences class in each indicated section.

» **HELMETS** - All professionals and non-professionals riding on Paso Park property must wear securely fastened protective headgear, which meets ASTM/SEI standards and carries the SEI tag. Any rider violating this rule at any time will immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.

» **HUNTER PRIZE MONEY** - The total amount of rated and unrated hunter prize money being offered at the competition (343126 & 343101: \$31,450; 343111 & 346515: \$26,450), the minimum amount of guaranteed rated and unrated hunter prize money payout (\$0.00), and the total amount of rated and unrated hunter prize money offered and paid out by the competition in the prior year (343126: \$31,650.28, 343111: \$16,552.94, 346515: This is a new competition, 343101: \$20,757.50).

» **JUDGING CRITERIA** - To be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise stated. No person will be allowed in the show ring during the time of judging except the exhibitor and those having official or requested duties to perform.

» **JUMPING ORDER** - Orders of go will be established by the back gate personnel. Management and show staff may change the order at any time. These orders will be established by either computer or manual draw.

» **JUMPER TIES** - Ties for other than first place to be broken by time taken in the first round.

» **NON COMP/HORS CONCOURS ROUND** - Non-comp rounds may be permitted, but only at management's discretion. In the situation where a round is permitted, the cost will be the full price of a related normal competition round. A horse may not compete in any subsequent judged rounds on the same day a non-comp round is permitted.

» **PRIZE MONEY** - Classes awarding prize money must have at least three entries complete the course to pay, unless otherwise specified by USEF rules. If there are less than three competitors, the management may choose to still run the class with or without prize money or combine the class with another. In the instance of combined classes, the lower prize money and class entry fee will be utilized unless otherwise specified by management.

» **RDNE FEE** - It is the full responsibility of the competitor and trainer to ensure they have properly entered any and all classes they intend to compete in. A "ride-did-not-enter" (RDNE) fee of \$25 will be added in addition to the cost of the class for any rounds competed that cannot be supported by office-approved paperwork.

» **SAFE SPORT** - All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

» **SCHOOLING** - No juniors or amateurs are allowed to school over fences without their trainer in the arena.

» **TIES** - In the event of a tie, both will be awarded the placing tied for, unless otherwise stated.

» **TIMER WALKS** - Timer walks may be permitted, but only with advanced permission from management before the start of the class. If a timer walk is utilized to qualify for the related Classic, the competitor will be responsible for paying the full cost of competing in every class in that section.

» **WARM-UP ROUNDS** - The day prior to the start of the competition, ticketed schooling with assigned times to heights will take place in all competition rings at \$50/ticket. A schedule will be posted noting the height changes. Competitor numbers must be worn during schooling. Additional warm-up classes have been included in the schedule during competition days. No poling or offsets allowed.

RULES & REGULATIONS (CONT.)

FACILITY

» **ARENAS** - All arenas at the Paso Robles Horse Park contain premier GGT Footing. The show and warm-up arenas measure as follows:

- > Butterfield Arena: 150' x 275'

- > Grand Prix Warm-Up: 150' x 275'
- > Warm-Up Arena #3: 150' x 275'

» **CELL PHONES** - Active use of cell phones and all cellular transmission devices is not permitted in any competition or warm-up arena.

» **DOGS** - All dogs at the Paso Robles Horse Park must be on a leash or tied at all times. There will be a \$50 penalty for any dogs off-leash or owners who do not pick up after their dogs.

» **EMERGENCY CARE** - Twin Cities Community Hospital Emergency Room is 11 miles away from the Paso Park at 1100 Las Tablas Road, Templeton, CA 93465.

» **LEVEL 1 TRAUMA CENTER** - Community Regional Medical Center is 109 miles away from the Paso Park at 2823 Fresno Street, Fresno, CA 93721.

» **LUNGING** - Lunging is only permitted in the two designated lunging arenas. There is no mounted riding or schooling of any sort of jumps permitted in the lunging arenas. There is a \$500 fine for lunging in non-designated arenas. Footing in these areas is comprised of mesa sand footing.

» **MEDICAL WASTE** - In accordance with the 1989 Federal Waste Tracking Act, which restricts the disposal of medical waste, bio-hazardous medical waste containers will be provided in the stable area. All exhibitors and their agents are responsible for the proper disposal of this waste.

» **NON-SMOKING FACILITY** - Please refrain from smoking or use of any vape products while on the facility.

» **PARK SAFETY & SURVEILLANCE** - In an effort to protect horses, competitors and the safety of the Paso Park, certain areas of the facility are under video/sound/photo surveillance. By competing at or attending competitions at the Paso Robles Horse Park you authorize any surveillance of your activities while on the premises. The Paso Robles Horse Park is responsible for the management of the surveillance system and has exclusive control of the release of video/audio/images.

» **PHOTO & VIDEO CONSENT** - By competing at or attending competitions or events at the Paso Robles Horse Park, you grant permission to unrestricted rights to use photographs and/or video footage of you, your horse, your pets, your family, and/or your guests for the purpose of promotion of the Paso Park in various mediums.

» **PRIVATE FACILITY** - This is a privately owned and operated facility. Any horse on the grounds must be associated with and entered into the current competition taking place. Cases of exception, including utilizing the facility to transfer shipping horses, must be approved through the management.

» **SHARPS** - Sharps containers are located on the backside of every barn building. They are checked and emptied regularly.

» **STALLS** - Stalls on-site are 12' x 12' with Dutch doors. Stalls have rubber mat flooring. Each stall has access to electricity and there are four water spickets in each stall aisle. Due to the unpredictable nature of the industry, stall assignments aren't finalized until 72 hours before the first day of competition. We do our best to accommodate all requests, but are constrained by various factors. Stalls are assigned based on previous attendance at Paso Park-managed shows, sponsorships, barn size, and our ability to maximize the use of these stalls.

» **TRAILER PARKING** - All trailers must be parked in the designated trailer parking lot near the entrance of the Park. Any trailer not parked in the correct location may be booted and applicable to a \$50 fee.

» **VIP PARKING** - Restricted vehicle access to the barns and VIP Parking begins Wednesday at 6 a.m. and continues until the completion of the show on Sunday. Any vehicles parking in locations that they have not purchased a V.I.P. pass for will be "booted" by Paso Park security. A fee of \$150 will be due to have the boot removed.

SHOW OFFICE

» **ADDS & SCRATCHES** - Entries into and scratches from any classes should be conducted in the horse show office by 5:00 p.m. the day before to avoid fees. Entries made after this time will be considered "same day" and will only be accepted if the schedule is not full. Classes with less than six (6) entries at 5:00 p.m. the day before may be canceled or combined at management's discretion. Management will take USEF and USHJA Zone 10 rules into consideration when making choices related to combining or splitting classes.

» **DISCREPANCIES and/or BILLING ERRORS** - The show office is open and available until the completion of the last class on Sunday. If after "closing out" with the office a billing discrepancy is noted, competitors have 72 hours after the end of the show to send email communication to office@pasorobleshorsepark.com. After that point, all billing is final.

» **ENTRIES MADE AT THE SHOW** - Entries made the Tuesday of the show week or later during the show will incur a \$150 office fee.

» **FEED, SHAVINGS, AND GRAIN** - The Paso Robles Horse Park Feed Office will be open during show dates and will be offering hay, shavings, and grain feed. For advance orders please email feed@PasoRoblesHorsePark.com or complete the online feed form. Orders can also be made at the show in the office. Please note there will be no same day grain deliveries. Competitors may bring their own feed and bedding but they may not receive a feed or bedding delivery from an outside company.

» **LATE FEES** - Entries received after Closing Day will be charged a \$100 office fee. Entries made after 8 a.m. of the day prior to ticketed warm-ups will be charged a \$150 office fee.

» **MAILED ENTRIES** - All entries must be postmarked by Entry Closing deadlines noted on page 5 with all required numbers and signatures to receive early entry status.

RULES & REGULATIONS (CONT.)

» **NON-COMPETING HORSES** — All horses on the grounds must be entered to compete in classes. If you are not planning to show, a \$150 non-competing fee will apply. All horses on the grounds will be assigned a number. To be considered a competing horse an entry must be shown in judged classes.

» **OFFICE FEE** — A fee of \$175 will be charged to each horse for the week of competition. This is the only per horse fee and it includes medical personnel and emergency response, entry software, access to all photos, security, horse health, and office support. There are no nomination fees charged at these shows.

» **OPEN BALANCES** — Competitors who do not come into the office to close out at the end of the show forfeit the right to adjustments on any show charges. Final balances will be automatically charged to the payment method on file. Competitors who fail to submit a valid form of payment for the full amount of their show bill by 5 p.m. on Sunday of the show week, will be charged a \$50 office fee.

» **PAST CREDITS/BALANCES** — Competitors may be notified of any previous Paso Park activity at the time of check-in. Outstanding balances must be paid prior to picking up show numbers. Outstanding balances may be deducted from prize money payments. Unpaid balances may prevent a competitor and/or their trainer of record from having stall reservations accepted. If a balance remains unpaid for more than 30 days the office may require a \$2,000 deposit payment before processing future entries.

» **PAYMENT** — All payments should be paid by credit card, cash, or check made payable to Paso Robles Horse Park Foundation. Any checks returned by the bank will be charged a \$150 penalty or 10% of the face value of the check, whichever is greater. Payments made by check or cash will receive a \$10 voucher for credit towards Paso Park Merchandise. No credit card fees are charged. Competitors that fail to submit a valid form of payment for the full amount of their show bill by 5pm on Sunday of the show week will be charged a \$50 office fee.

» **REFUNDS** — Past the closing dates on page 5, but at least 48 hours in advance of the first day of competition show scratches will require a note from either a doctor or veterinarian explaining the reason the competitor or horse cannot compete, acceptable at management's discretion. A competitor may replace one entry with another horse. If no replacement is made or note is received, competitors are responsible for the full stall fees and a \$50 office fee. Stalls are non-refundable. In all cases, a \$50 office charge will still be applicable.

» **SAME DAY FEES** — Any same day adds will be charged a fee of \$5 per transaction. Once the class has begun a competitor cannot add or scratch from that class unless an exception is made by management. Same day entries may go first in order, regardless of when the order is drawn.

» **SHOW SCRATCHES** — Up until the Entry Closing date you may make changes to or cancel your entries and related stall reservations. After that point you are fully responsible for the stall fee related to each specific horse's entry and for a \$50 office fee. At management's discretion, entry fees will be refunded in full, less a \$50 office charge, with veterinary certificate or medical doctor's note submitted via email at least 48 hours prior to the start of the show's first judged class. For more information on refunds and show scratches, refer to page 7 of this prize list.

» **TEXT ALERTS** — All trainers will be automatically enrolled in text updates utilizing the contact information submitted with entries or stall reservations. At the start of the show there will be an introductory text that allows the opportunity to opt-out.

» **TRAINER SPLITS** — Trainers may choose to add tack/grooming, feed and bedding orders, RV reservations, competitor show expenses, or any other miscellaneous show purchases to their "trainer splits." Trainers have until 5 p.m. on Friday of the show to complete the trainer split form indicating which competitor accounts to apply the division of expenses to and how to apply the division. If they do not complete this form by the deadline, the office may charge the full amount to the trainer's payment on file. It is fully and solely the trainer's responsibility to indicate what items are applicable to the split and how it should be applied. By completing and submitting your entry form with the indicated trainer's name on it, you accept the responsibility to be financially responsible for any assigned splits from that trainer for all costs related to the show you are entering. The horse show management is not able to intervene in a trainer's direction of how to assign those expenses.

» **VACCINATIONS AND HORSE HEALTH** - Per GR845 Equine Vaccination Rule: At Federation licensed competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Competitors may be asked to provide proof of vaccination upon check-in or prior to entering the property.

DISCLAIMERS

» Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of the horse show management, but management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show, the officials, contractors, and employees of the show blameless for any loss or accident to his/her/their horse, employees, equipment, which may occur from sickness, fire, or otherwise.

» The management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit entries, and cancel award prizes without claims for damages; to cancel or combine unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges.

» Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the management, judges, or officials, on the part of the owner, trainer, manager, rider, or groom shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit entry fee and other fees.

» Show management reserves to itself the power to prohibit any person from attending or showing a horse in the ring and to remove any trainer, competitor, groom, or horse from the show without being liable for compensation.

» All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the show management whose decision shall be final.

» EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

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MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

THIS DOCUMENT WAIVES IMPORTANT LEGAL RIGHTS. READ IT CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING.

1. Consideration & Acknowledgment of Risk. In consideration for being permitted to participate in equestrian activities, including but not limited to competitions, training, riding, handling, and any related events at the Park, I, the undersigned, acknowledge and agree as follows:

a. I understand and acknowledge that equestrian activities are inherently dangerous and involve significant risks of serious bodily injury, illness (including communicable diseases), permanent disability, paralysis, or death to myself, my horse(s), and others. I further acknowledge that these risks include, but are not limited to, falls, collisions, unpredictable animal behavior, equipment failure, and the negligence of other participants, spectators, and event organizers.

b. I represent that I have the necessary training, experience, and physical ability to participate safely and that I will comply with all rules and regulations of the Paso Robles Horse Park Foundation (the "Foundation"), Paso Robles Horse Park, LLC ("PHRP"), and any governing equestrian bodies.

2. Waiver and Release of Liability. To the fullest extent permitted by law, I voluntarily release, waive, and discharge the Park, the Foundation, PHRP, and their respective officers, directors, managers, employees, agents, volunteers, affiliated organizations, insurers, sponsors, and vendors (collectively, the "Released Parties") from any and all claims, demands, causes of action, liabilities, costs, or expenses, including attorney's fees, arising out of or related to any injury, death, or property damage that I, my horse(s), or my guests may suffer while at the Park, whether caused by the negligence of the Released Parties or otherwise.

3. Express Assumption of Risk. I voluntarily assume all risks of injury or death for myself and my horse(s), and for property damage associated with my participation in equestrian activities at the Park, including risks that may arise from the negligence of the Released Parties.

4. Indemnification and Hold Harmless. I agree to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the Released Parties from any claims, damages, liabilities, costs, or expenses (including attorney's fees) arising from:

- a. Any injury, death, or property damage caused by me or my horse(s) while at the Park;
- b. Any claims brought by third parties against the Released Parties due to my actions or the actions of my horse(s); and
- c. Any failure on my part to comply with Park rules or applicable regulations.

5. Waiver of Unknown Claims (California Civil Code § 1542). I expressly waive any rights under **California Civil Code § 1542**, which states:

"A general release does not extend to claims that the creditor or releasing party does not know or suspect to exist in his or her favor at the time of executing the release and that, if known by him or her, would have materially affected his or her settlement with the debtor or released party."

I acknowledge that I understand the significance of this waiver and that I am giving up any potential future claims that I may not presently be aware of.

6. Scope & Binding Effect. This agreement is binding upon me, my heirs, assigns, legal representatives, and any minors for whom I am signing as a parent or legal guardian. If any provision of this agreement is held invalid, the remainder shall remain in full force and effect.

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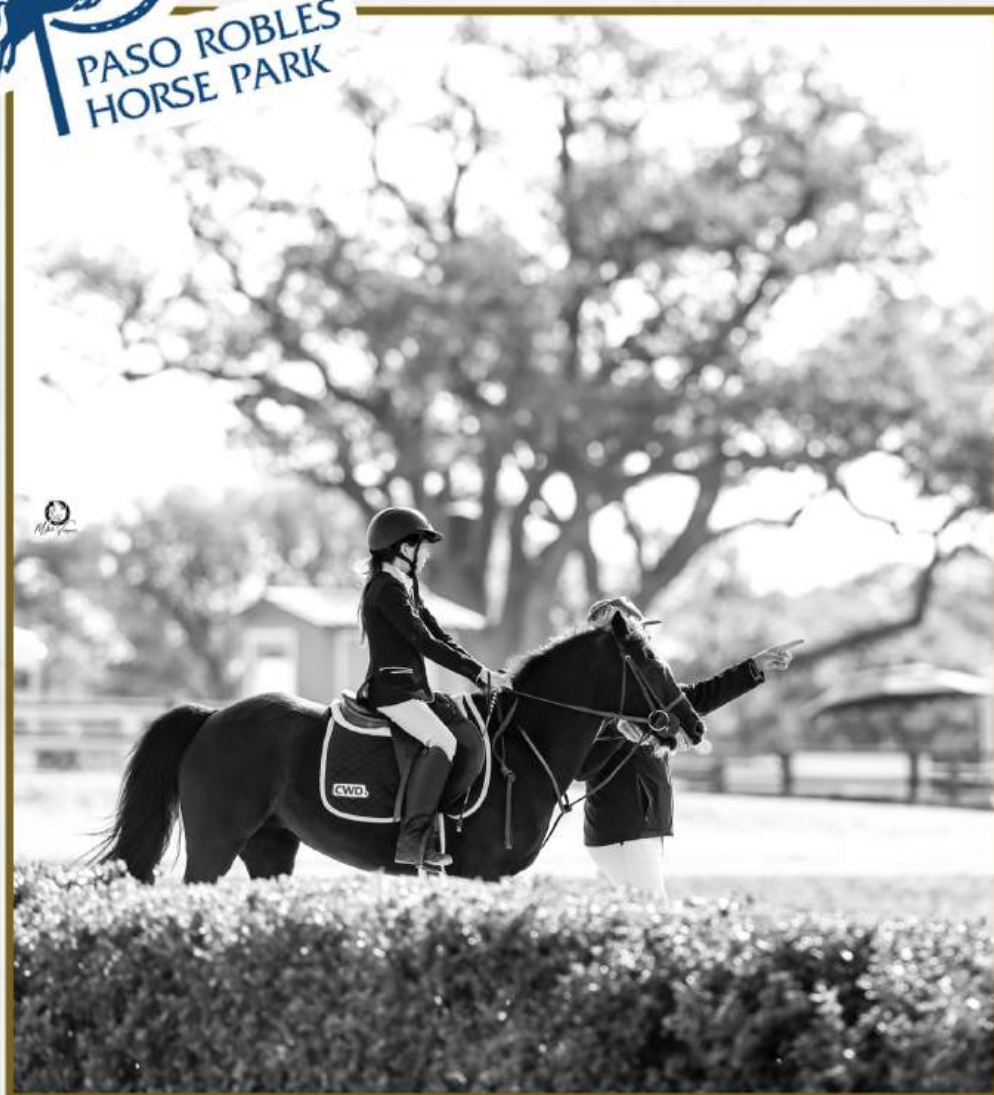
